**RESIDENT SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM-**  
Helping Improve Lives

Assisting residents of our Member housing agencies further their education is just one more way that HAI Group commits to giving back to the community.

Sponsored by Housing Authority Insurance, Inc. (HAI), this program provides scholarships to residents of Member housing agencies so that they can attend college for the first time or complete their education.

Residents of our Members residing in public or housing choice voucher (HCV) housing can apply for a chance to receive one of the 50 scholarships, worth \$2,500 each. This year alone, \$125,000 in scholarship funding will be awarded.

Since the program began, HAI Group has invested more than \$680,000 to provide educational opportunities to more than 270 public and HCV housing residents.

**Application Deadline: 04/30/2016**

**Scholarship Eligibility Requirements:**

1. I am a US Citizen.
2. I am currently attending college or plan to attend a college, university, or technical school.
3. I have been a public housing or Section 8 resident for at least six months
4. I have uploaded a HS transcript, college transcript or copy of my GED.
