Or try this: Egg Site Words



To make these popsicle's you will need:

- Fruit juice
- Eco Friendly Easter Eggs
- Lollipop sticks
- A large nail and thumbtack
- Small funnel or piping tip to fill the eggs

First, tip the eggs upside down and poke three holes in the bottom. Two of these holes are for letting the air escape when filling the egg, the third one should be in the center of the bottom. Make this center hole bigger using the large nail. You will need it to be as big as the popsicle/sucker stick. Once that is done, and you have your egg carton full of "hole-y" eggs, use the piping tip to fill each one until almost full, and then poke in the popsicle stick and place in the freezer until firm (I froze mine overnight).

RECREATION SCHOLARSHIPS AVAILABLE

The Jefferson County Dept. of Social Services is now accepting applications for local youths. The scholarships are "for children and youths who do not have the opportunity to participate in recreational, social or cultural events, and who are at risk for not developing to their fullest potential." The state Office of Children and Family Services provides funding for such scholarships, which may include money for sports-league fees, karate or adventure-program fees, computer camps, and dance, art or music lessons. Scholarships up to \$400 will be awarded.

The nominated youth must meet ALL of the following criteria:

- Under the age of 21
- A current resident of Jefferson County or attending school in Jefferson County

Determined to have documented financial need due to ONE OR MORE of the following:

- Eligible for food stamps (family or youth)
- Receiving free or reduced school lunch program
- Family receiving Public Assistance
