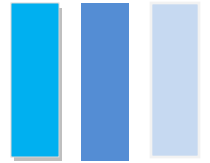




## Get the Facts: About Recycling



*All residents, schools, and businesses are required to separate recyclable materials from their trash.*

- **What is recyclable?:** Bottles, containers, tubs, paper, newspaper, magazines, paperback books, cereal boxes, bottles, jars, tin, aluminum, cardboard boxes, milk & juice packaging, and more!
- **What is e-waste?** E-Waste stands for Electronic Waste. This is waste that CANNOT be thrown in the dumpsters. This includes things such as TV's, VCR's, Computers, Printers, Stereos, Video Game Consoles, Cell phones, Cable Boxes, Cords, Batteries, Air Conditioners, Vacuums, and more!
- **Where can I recycle my E-Waste?** There are free collection events each year.
