RECREATION SCHOLARSHIPS AVAILABLE

The Jefferson Cty Dept of Social Services is now accepting applications for local youths. The scholarships are "for children and youths who do not have the opportunity to participate in recreational, social or cultural events, and who are at risk for not developing to their fullest potential." The state Office of Children and Family Services provides funding for such scholarships, which may include money for sports-league fees, karate or adventure-program fees, computer camps, and dance, art or music lessons. Scholarships up to \$400 will be awarded.
